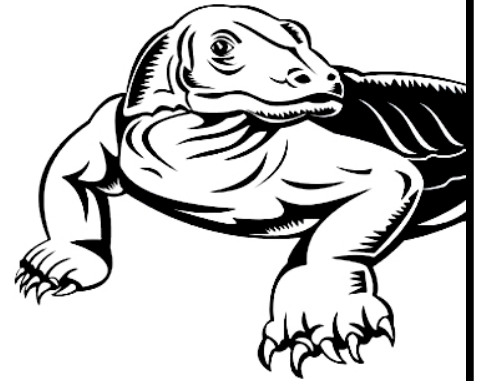


KOMODO DRAGONS

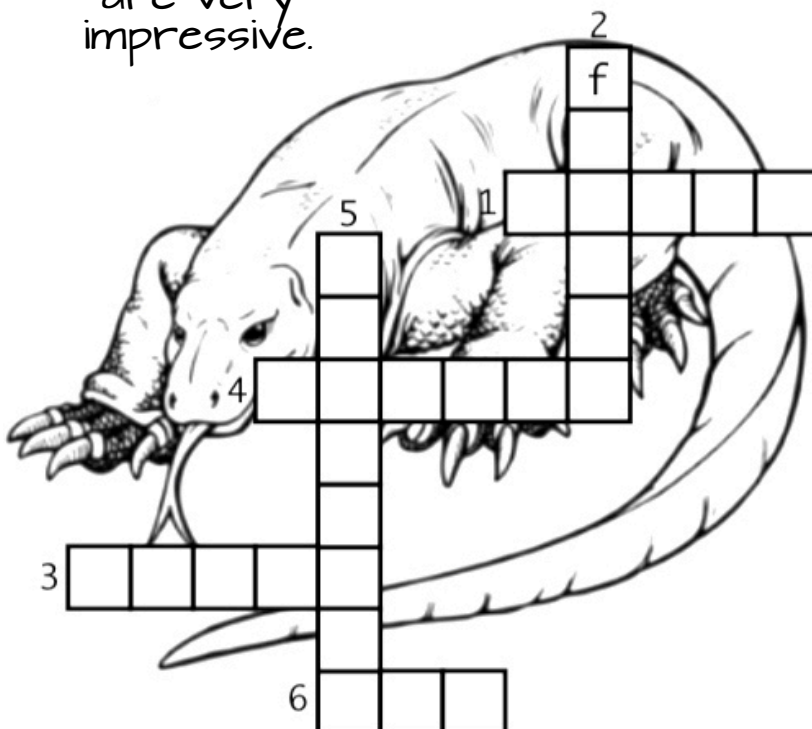

The Komodo dragon is the largest species of lizard. It can be found on four islands in Indonesia, north of Australia. It attacks anything that approaches it. It has sharp teeth and very large claws. Komodo dragons can eat animals that are larger than them. They will sometimes also eat baby Komodo dragons.



Komodo dragons can be grey, brown, black or green. Like snakes, they have forked tongues that they use to detect their prey from very far away. They spend a lot of time alone. Komodo dragons are excellent swimmers. They can run as quickly as you can. During the day, they like to soak up the sun.
